Owner of Popular Attraction Is Sued

Girl Was Sexually Molested by Owner

He Runs Park in Castro Valley, Site of Many Kids' Parties

The granddaughter of the owner of Crow Canyon Park in Castro Valley is suing her grandfather, Alexander Shpil, Sr., for sexual molestation.

The suit, filed in Alameda County Superior Court, alleges that her aunt Maureen Shpil and uncle Alan Shpil also molested the girl.

“This girl and her loved ones are worried about others who may have been hurt at campground,” said her attorney, Dr. Joseph C. George of Sacramento (916 442 7100, 916 802 7949). “It’s frightening to think of the sheer number of kids that the Shpils have had access to at the park over the years.”

According to the suit, Maureen Shpil disclosed to the victim that Maureen’s father, Alexander Shpil, Sr. had also molested Maureen.

Alan Shpil lives on the premises of Crow Canyon Park.
